Using the Seed Swap

1. Label seed envelopes with details of seeds to be donated, include; plant name / date, maybe add plant info such as height / spread / description / growing tips
2. Portion out seeds to be donated in to your labelled envelope(s)
3. Deposit your labelled seed envelope(s) into the appropriate container i.e. Flower or Vegetable within the **Ketton Seed Swap** box
4. **Help yourself to seed envelopes** already donated in the box, ensuring there is enough for everyone
5. If you have seedlings, place a note of their availability in the appropriate box with a telephone number or post a note on the group facebook page.

Swap Box Etiquette

Take only what you need enabling others to benefit from our community scheme. Please don't forget to close the door securely of the seed swap box.

Don't forget to tell you friends and neighbours.

Please ensure your hands have been cleaned and do not access the seed swap whilst feeling unwell. Follow Covid19 guidelines set out at <https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus>

Depositing Seeds

When harvesting seeds for the seed swap box please be mindful to only take seeds from healthy plants. Avoid collecting seeds that have been lying around on the ground as they may have aged or experienced insect attack. Please feel free to deposit seeds that are bought but not needed. Seeds should no older than 3 years old. **Please, no seeds from invasive plants.**
