(TEMPORARY FOOTPATH CLOSURE NOTICE)
Footpath E229
Parish of Ketton Order 2022**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Closure) Footpath E229 Parish of Ketton Order 2022 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the footpath should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on the footpath

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all traffic will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of footpath known as **Footpath E229 from the junction with the High Street to the end of the development site.**

The closure is to enable Beeson Wright Ltd to undertake site redevelopment works

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 13th April 2022 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 184 days. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: **from 13th April 2022 to 13th October 2022**

An alternative route around the works will be installed for the duration of the closure.

The alternative route will be via the route shown on the attached plan and as shown on <https://one.network>

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
