

## **Have you heard of The Whitebread Trust ?**

The Whitebread Trust was set up over 100 years ago, and is a village trust that provides grants to individuals and clubs in the village.

The Trust makes grants to residents for a variety of reasons : e.g. those moving to secondary education, taking a vocational course, other training or taking part in extra-curricular trips from school, and the Duke of Edinburgh Awards Scheme. However, grants are also made to residents of any age.

We support local clubs or organisations that need additional funds to improve their facilities or equipment.

Currently there are two active projects intended to support residents experiencing difficulties caused by the economic situation. Details can be obtained from the Parish Office.

The trustees meet four times a year to consider applications. The meetings are held in February, May(AGM), August and November.
